## SUPPLY LIST Cowpens Elementary 2009 - 2010 School Year

- Bookbag (no rollers or wheels)
- One box of Crayola markers (broadline/washable )
- One large white rectangular eraser
- One pair of blunt end scissors
- Four boxes of Crayola crayons (8 color)
- One pack of #2 pencils
- One large pencil box
- Four large glue sticks
- Two marbled notebooks (MEAD primary-black and white)

### OPTIONAL:

- One bottle of antibacterial soap
- One container of baby wipes
- One box Ziploc freezer bags (quart and/or gallon)
- One large box Kleenex

- Two large rectangular erasers (Pink Pearl type)

- Kleenex

- Box of Clorox Wipes or Baby Wipes

- Three 1 inch binders

- Two Mead marble composition notebooks

- #2 pencils with erasers
- Two highlighters
- Colored pencils or crayons
- Scissors
- Four glue sticks
- Red ink pen

Optional:

- Box of Kleenex

- 3-three-whole punched, spiral bound notebooks 70-90 pages (2 will be put up until needed)\*\*

**SCIENCE**

- 2 composition books – no spirals on these (1 will be put up until needed)\*\*

\*\* Parents may choose to purchase one for now, instead of all three needed for the year, but keep in mind that students will need a new notebook as soon as the one currently being used is filled)

GENERAL USE

- 1- three-inch, three ring binder – anything less than 3 inches will not hold the material needed- We have found that the “D” ring binders are stronger and will hold more. The round ring binders are weaker and many begin to fall apart mid-year.
- 1 pack of section dividers with tabs for notebook
- 1- two-pocket folder
- 1 pack of # 2 pencils (**not mechanical**)
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 red pen
- 1 blue or black pen
- 1 highlighter of any color
- 1 pack of notebook paper
- 1 zippered pencil pouch that can be put into notebook
- 1 rectangular eraser that is separate from the pencil

Optional

- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer (waterless)

- 1 box of tissues

\*\* Crayons, markers, rulers, and other school supplies not listed above, are not needed at this time. **Please do not send these to school unless requested by a teacher at a later date.**
