



Immunization Requirements for Children Entering 4 Year-Old Kindergarten in 2010-2011

- 4 doses of Diphtheria, Pertussis, and Tetanus vaccine
- 3 doses of Polio vaccine
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
- Influenza type b vaccination - age appropriate
- 1 dose of Rubeola (Measles) vaccination received on or after the 1st birthday
- 1 dose of Rubella (German Measles) vaccination received on or after the 1st birthday
- 1 dose of Mumps vaccine received on or after the 1st birthday
- 1 dose of Varicella (chickenpox) vaccine received on or after the 1st birthday or has your child had chicken pox
- Pneumococcal vaccination - age appropriate

Immunization Requirements for Children Entering 5 Year-Old Kindergarten or 6th Grade in 2010-2011

- Students who will enter 5 year old kindergarten in 2010-2011 must receive 3 doses of polio vaccine, with at least one dose received after the 4th birthday.
- Students who will enter 6th grade in 2010-2011 must have received a 4th dose of diphtheria, tetanus, and pertussis vaccine.
